

MAINTENANCE OF RESIN FLOORS

RECOMMENDATIONS for CLEANING:

Having invested in a high quality flooring system, such as a resin coating or screed, it is essential that a regular cleaning regime is adopted. This will not only enhance the appearance and life of the floor finish by removing dirt and contamination, but will also ensure that floors are kept safe and hygienic and free from slip hazards.

Designer Resin Floors Ltd has a range of maintenance cleaning products specifically for resin floor finishes. Formulated using natural derived and ecologically sound material, the range of products contains no caustic alkalis, harmful solvents, phosphates, silicates or aggressive biocides. They are safe in use and have a superior environmental profile.

FREQUENCY:

Cleaning should be carried out on a regular basis, frequency will largely depend on the type of contamination and level of cleanliness required. For maximum effectiveness, cleaning should be carried out on a daily or weekly basis as part of standard housekeeping procedures.

THE PRODUCT:

RESIN FLOOR CLEANER

A versatile aqueous floor cleaner and degreaser. Its powerful cleaning action effortlessly removes most types of soiling including greases, grime, oils and hydrocarbons. Resin Floor Cleaner leaves no smear or residue upon rinsing. Suitable for use with non-abrasive manual systems with cold or warm water OR with non-abrasive floor scrubber/drying machines.

DILUTION RATE: 1:20 to 1:50

ESTIMATED COVER: 50m² to 250m²

MAINTENANCE CLEANING:

This system is designed for regular maintenance as part of standard housekeeping.

Gloss or Satin finishes have a tighter, closed surface profile and are the easiest to remove dirt and grime.

Matt finish have a slightly open surface profile and will require more care and attention in cleaning to remove dirt and grime.

Floors with a glitter, flake or anti-slip finishes may benefit from the use of a, non abrasive, semi-stiff nylon or similar brush incorporated into part of the cleaning regime to stop dirt building up in the pores or texture of the surface.

With all resin floors it is important to thoroughly wet the surface with the appropriate diluted cleaner to loosen dirt and grime and rinse thoroughly with clean water.

PREPARATION:

Where possible, move portable equipment/machinery to one side to leave a clear unobstructed floor areas.

Sweep floor to remove loose material and surface debris.

MAINTENANCE CLEANING:

To a Combination floor scrubber/dryer machine, attach red pads or stiff nylon brushes as applicable for the floor finish and carefully add a 2% solution (1:50) or Resin Floor Cleaner to the machine tank.

Use the floor scrubber/dryer machine and simultaneously scrub the floor and wet vacuum the soiled water into the recovery tank.

For heavy soiled floors make the first pass of the machine without using the vacuum facility, this leaves the product in contact with the dirt longer and aids removal. On the second pass, scrub the floor and recover soiling as normal. Stubborn stains such as wine, tea, crayon or score marks from furniture, use warm water and rub with Sodium Bicarbonate Paste. Rinse at least twice.

Depending on the floor area, it may be necessary to change the red pad during this operation.

Alternatively, dilute Resin Floor Cleaner at a rate of 1:20-50 with warm water in a mop bucket.

Apply solution generously to small section of the floor and clean with a soft mop for gloss surfaces or a firm, but non abrasive, sponge preferably with a folding squeeze action for matt or satin finishes, used in a figure eight motion, repeat until floor area has been completely covered and all dirt/grime loosened.

Rinse thoroughly with clean warm water and dry.
